A little bit about us.

The United Methodist Creation Justice Movement has been instrumental in working within Annual Conferences and General Conference to get stuff done.

The United Methodist Creation Justice Movement burst into life in Nashville, Tennessee, in 2019, when a group of long-time United Methodist climate and creation care advocates gathered to address both the climate crisis and the frustrating inaction of The United Methodist Church. At that summit it was decided: they needed to start a grassroots revival movement. And they did.

It was 1980 when the church first acknowledged global warming, yet the response to the environmental crisis by the church is still inadequate. This is where the Movement seeks to make a difference, mobilizing and empowering people in local churches and holding church leaders accountable to take faithful action.

Since 2019, the United Methodist Creation Justice Movement has grown every which way, from Florida to Minnesota, New England to Montana, Oregon to North Carolina, Texas to Virginia and more.
